On the wave of a very successful Canada Day we have extended our drive-thru food truck experience bi-weekly for the summer. Each date will have a new group of BC's Best Food Trucks.

Produced by West Coast Pop Up's, this is a collective group of small businesses who have operated through the Covid pandemic by either sharing their revenue with other struggling businesses or with charities like the Royal Columbian Hospital Foundation.

This event is possible due to the support of the Sapperton Business Association, Royal Columbian Hospital Foundation, City of New Westminster, Fraser Health and local businesses.

In order to comply with the current Covid related health order we are required to operate as a drive-thru food truck event. This is to protect the safety of the public, the businesses and our staff. It is intended to ensure that there are no mass gatherings and for the ability to Covid trace if necessary.

Although this is not our preferred method of operation we support it as we are doing what we can to support these small businesses and the Royal Columbian Hospital Foundation.

Working closely with the Fraser Health Authority, **as of July 20th**, we have been **APPROVED** to add a "GRAB and GO" walk up system and can now offer the general public this added alternative service moving forward. **Please note that other participants must still stay in their vehicle!**

Only debit & credit will be accepted! No Cash accepted, No walk-ups, No bicycles and guests must drive-thru and stay in their vehicle.
